Poinsettia's are back for the holidays!

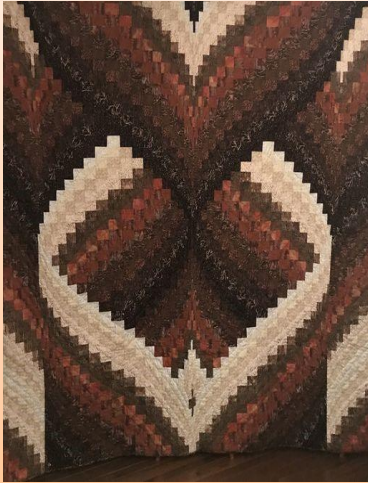
