The meeting began with prayer.

- Liz submitted the Treasurer's Report indicating that we are still on track for 2022.
- Chad recognized Ally Bozeka and all the leadership she has brought to the children of MCCC over the past 6 years. We are planning a celebration for her on April 3<sup>rd</sup> following worship. Chad has increased his home and hospital visitations and has had his first meeting with the General Board of the Christian Church who he was appointed to this year.
