

March 2020 Trustees' Report

The refurbishment of the Fellowship Hall was started and continues this month under the leadership of C.J. Delaney as the project for his Eagle Scout rank and achievement. This project should be completed in the next two to three weeks.

The fire extinguishers in the church were inspected and recertified at the beginning of the month.

In participating in the Fellowship Hall project, I was thinking about the potential for someone needing some medical attention, (for example, a cut finger or abrasion). In looking around for a first aid kit in case of something of this nature occurring, I only found a couple bandaids in a drawer in the kitchen. In further searching around, Nora Brant found a small kit in a cupboard in the KWM assembly room, (the old nursery), that was depleted of supplies. Unless somebody knows of other first aid kits in the building, I recommend that the Trustees look into obtaining two, maybe three more substantial kits to be placed in prominent locations around the church.

Pat and Mike Hoskin installed a new mat inside the narthex entrance. Smaller mats were also placed inside and outside the Education wing entrance to replace worn out mats.
