

How our proposed addition might look

These images are generated by AI (Artificial Intelligence). If they had been by Actual Intelligence they'd have been more accurate, but they give a hint of the appearance of the first floor of our proposed addition.

I arbitrarily chose beige walls and laminate flooring, but of course we could actually have any color and any kind of flooring for the actual building.



Here's a view of the first floor of the addition, viewed from the stairs coming down from the second floor. The wall straight ahead is the back wall of the church.

You see the compliant restroom in the corner; another is directly above it on the sanctuary level. To the left is the door from the parking lot. The brown rectangle on the wall represents the passage into the Fellowship Hall; it and the elevator door would of course be much wider.

The computer placed the elevator right into the church wall; it actually will stand in front of the wall, at a right angle. The arrow shows how you would enter the elevator.

Here's a view from the window on the left (west) side of the addition. The wall on the left is along the back wall of the church. This image is better in some ways, as it shows the elevator correctly, perpendicular to the wall of the church, and the elevator door is proportioned more appropriately. You see the stairs on the right, coming down from the sanctuary level of the addition. At the very left edge is the frame of the door coming in from the parking lot.

However, the rest room would actually be behind the elevator, not next to it. And there would be a passageway in that wall on the left that leads into the Fellowship Hall.

Hopefully these computer-generated images give you some idea of how the new addition would look.
